
Says Jones' Augusta Course Is Unfinished

ARDMORE, Okla., May 7. — Perry Maxwell, the golf architect who rebuilt the Bobby Jones course in Augusta, says that the job is not completed. He seeks to remove certain piles of dirt which were tossed up for the purpose of making the natives imagine they were surrounded by British coastal sand dunes. They do not fit into the natural beauty of the Georgia countryside.

Maxwell thinks that one of the few spots on this continent which provides country resembling the linksland of Great Britain is the terrain over which he built the Prairie Dunes course in Hutchinson, Kan., for Emerson Carey, jr. This course, he believes, is destined to become famous.
