Work is progressing at a rapid pace on the new course being built by the Enid Country club. Perry Maxwell, the internationally known golf architect, of Ardmore, already has laid out the course and his son, Pres, or otherwise known as Perry jr., is on the job supervising the construction work.

Greens Roughed

The greens already have been roughed in and the tees constructed. The greens will be planted with bent, the tees bermuda. Various members of the organized Enid club are doing much of the labor on the course.

The members are working each weekend in clearing the land, hauling away trash and other such tasks. And

they're having fun doing it.

Work will begin soon in drilling water wells for the course. Water lines are being laid now. Construction work on both the clubhouse and swimming pool will begin before summer and members believe that the clubhouse will be completed by November at least. The course will be ready for play early next spring.

The new Enid club now has 300 members, 154 of whom put \$1,000 into

the enterprise.
