

## NEW COUNTRY CLUB IS PLANNED AND LAID OUT

Perry Maxwell, Golf Architect, Has Been Here Doing Work—Expect to Have Course North of McPherson Ready for Use by Early Fall.

Perry Maxwell, Tulsa, Okla., golf architect of national reputation, has completed the layout of the new golf course for the McPherson Country Club, about six miles north of McPherson on U. S. 81. Work is now being started on the actual construction of the project and by early fall it is believed that playing will be started.

All the tees have been staked off as well as the fairways. Two men are now at work building up the greens and approaches. It is understood that these men will be kept busy at the course for the remainder of the summer and there is a possibility that others may be put to work later.

The plans as drawn up by Mr. Maxwell also include layouts for a club house, swimming pool and other buildings that the Country Club officials hope to add to the new project from time to time.

Mr. Maxwell has been high in his praise for the natural hazards afforded at the new golf course. He said when here that when completed the new course will be one of the best in this part of the state.

The possibility of having grass greens at little or no extra expense is being considered by club officials upon the recommendation of Mr. Maxwell. There is a native sod that grows over the course that stands dry weather and is easily kept in condition.
