

ARDMORE GOES AFTER ANNUAL GOLF TOURNEY

Local Men Will Seek to Bring
Next Year's Annual Event
to This Country
Club.

Ardmore will make a bid for the 1924 golf tournament it was stated today by local golf bugs who will leave Saturday night and Sunday for Tulsa to attend the tourney starting on Monday morning.

In order to bring the tournament to Ardmore it will be necessary to double the size of the Dornick Hills links, making it 18 holes. Plans are under way for the extension of the links and remodeling of the club house at this time.

O. C. Lasher is to leave Saturday night for Oklahoma City where he will attend a meeting of insurance men on Sunday but on Monday he hopes to get the first Ardmoreite to tee off in the qualifying rounds.

Rees Evans and Perry Maxwell will lead a large delegation of golfers from here on Sunday and all members will be keyed up to stage a fight for the tournament. Other cities in the state have already pledged their support to the Ardmoreites in the fight for the honors.

Extensions and improvements at the local club will cost in the neighborhood of \$25,000 it was estimated several weeks ago.
