

## Golf Course At Dam Will Open On Saturday

KENTUCKY DAM VILLAGE STATE PARK, June 13. (Special)—Pine Hills Golf Course, the beautiful new nine-hole layout here, will officially open to the public Saturday morning. Conservation Commissioner Henry Ward announced today.

The 3,200-yard course has been open since June 1, but has been used by Kentucky Lake State Park and Kentucky Dam Village guests only.

Pro-Superintendent Brooks Starr has the new course in excellent condition, including the large greens and tees. The course is equipped with storm sewers and the many pine trees make the course difficult for even the best golfer.

Pine Hills Hall, a meeting house for state officials and which will also serve as the golf course clubhouse, is scheduled to be completed in the near future.

A large crowd is expected to visit the new course over the weekend. Green fees are \$1.50 for all day, \$1.25 for 18 holes and 75 cents for nine holes.
