

# Opening Day Of Play Scheduled Tomorrow At Rochelle Course

Rochelle, July 30. — All was in readiness here for the informal opening of the new Rochelle Town and Country club golf course tomorrow.

The one-hundred and fifty members of the private organization and their guests are expected to crowd the links tomorrow when the first test of the nine-hole course will be made. Although the greens are new and the bent grass has not yet formed an adequate "carpet" other playing conditions will be good.

Fairways, traps and all hazards are in good condition and ready for competition. Out-of-town golfers and Rochelle residents not members of the club will be permitted to play for the regular green fees.

It has been estimated that close to \$55,000 has been spent thus far. The land for the course was purchased last fall at a bankruptcy sale. W. C. Whitcomb is president; Fred E. Gardner, vice-president; and E. T. Berscheid is secretary-treasurer.

Formal inauguration of the club will be held this fall when the club house and other improvements have been completed.
