

Two Changes Made On Jones' Course

AUGUSTA, Ga., Nov. 12.—Perry Maxwell, former Oklahoma banker, who is architect to the Augusta National Golf club by appointment of Bob Jones, has made two changes in the course for the renewal of the Master's tournament. The green for the short 12th has been enlarged and bunkers cut into the hillside in the rear. A new green has been built 40 yards back of the former location at the seventh hole. Although Bob Jones felt that the original job done by the late Dr. MacKenzie was beyond reproach, he has yielded to wishes of others, and changes made in 1937 and this summer by Architect Maxwell have eliminated a number of the original features.
