

MAXWELL PLANS NEW GOLF COURSE

Delay in Work Caused by Designer's Absence From City;
Name Offer Still Open.

Final details for Ardmore's public golf course will probably be worked out this week, it was said yesterday by Virgil Short, chairman of the board of directors. Delay in actual construction work has been caused by the absence of Perry Maxwell, who is to design the course, from the city. Members of the board hope to close the deal for the land to be used within the next few days.

Meantime, the offer of a free membership for the best suggestion for a name for the club is still open. Several names have been proposed, but the lists will remain open until further notice.

There are no strings attached to the offer, the officials explain. All that is required is that the name of the sender be attached. The winning suggestion will give the inventor a year's membership in the club with playing privileges for himself and his wife.

The membership lists are still open and new charter members have been signed during the last week. The club has 50 members at present.
