PERRY MAXWELL BUILDING LINKS

Michigan University Course Progressing Rapidly Under Direction Ardmore Man.

Work on the University of Michigan golf course at Ann Arbor is going forward rapidly under the supervision of Perry Maxwell, nationally known golf course architect. Assisting him in the construction of this course are Greene Reeder and Dean Woods, formerly of Ardmore.

Fielding H. "Hurry Up" Yost, director of intercollegiate athletics is planing on paying for the \$500,000 course without using any of the athletic funds appropriated by the state. This institution has a stadium with seating capacity of 90,000 and annually takes in more money than does any other school from athletics in the United States.

Yost plans to charge \$5 annually for each student playing the course with an additional 75 cents for a locker key. He believes in never giving a student a thing but in turn thinks that this small fee will not prevent any of the students that are interested in playing golf from having membership.

This year will be the first season for more than 25 years that the veteran coach has not taken part in the coaching of the Wolverine football team but he will continue as director of intercollegiate athletics.
