

\$4,500,000 Spent On State's Parks

GILBERTSVILLE, Ky., Sept. 27 (AP) — Gov. Earle Clements declared here Tuesday night that four and a half million dollars has been spent or contracted for state park improvements during his administration.

The governor spoke at a dinner sponsored by the Paducah and Benton Lions Clubs as he stopped here on his annual governors tour of the state.

He said a large part of the money spent for park improvements already has come back through the highway fund and through increased taxes paid by Kentuckians whose income has increased.

He indicated that a golf course would be built at Kentucky Dam Village State Park by next summer.
