Sooners Plan New 18-Hole Golf Course

NORMAN, March 30—(P)— Tentative plans are being made for a new 18-hole golf course on the south campus at the University of Oklahoma, Walter W. Kraft, director of the university's physical plant, said Wednesday.

The university's present nine-hole course is the site of the new \$1,050,000 track field and stadium.

Kraft said under present plans the former Navy Officers club on the south campus, a naval traing center during World war II, will be used as a clubhouse for the new course.

"The navy must give its consent before we can start the actual work," Kraft said, "but I feel sure it will be glad for us to build it."

Proposed site of the new golf course is now under lease to the veterans administration. The VA planned to construct a neulro-psychiatrist hospital on the area, but the hospital has been eliminated from VA hospital building plans. Kraft said if the navy approves construction of the golf course, the VA also must be consulted.

Kraft said Perry Maxwell, Oklahoma golf course architect, had been selected to lay out the new course. Maxwell designed the \$40,000 University of Michigan course and many others throughout the nation.
