Although still very much in the preliminary stage, Riverdale Country Club has plans for remodeling the golf course there with possible relocation of greens and rebuilding of tees. The plans will be thoroughly studied by the club's board of governors after a conference with one of the country's leading golf architects, who has been on the scene and studied the layout.

However, there is nothing definite at this date. It's still in the "talking" stage.

Perry Maxwell of Tulsa has been at Riverdale, studying the course for possible changes. He's regarded as one of the country's best golf architects and has the contract for re-vamping the Dallas course where the 1952 National Open is to be played.

With splendid facilities including a new modern clubhouse, swimming pool, trap shooting field, Riverdale reportedly hopes to eventually sponsor a big-time golf tournament and gain an annual date on the touring pros' regular circuit.

"We have one of the finest club houses and facilities in the South, but our golf course is the same as when it was built 30 years ago," is the way one member put it.
