

MAXWELL, CITY CHAIRMAN OF THE SALVATION ARMY

Annual Appeal for the Budget
Fund to Be Made (Week
October 24 to 31.

At a meeting of the Carter County advisory board of the Salvation Army Perry D. Maxwell was elected city chairman to fill the vacancy created by P. C. Dings. J. E. Hamilton was retained as county chairman and Sam Donbe, vice chairman.

The date of the annual appeal for budget and building fund is set for the week of October 24 to 31. The board expects to raise \$10,000 in Carter county for annual budget and maintenance fund and the erection of a new Salvation Army building. From the funds raised last year there is a balance in cash of about \$4,000 and outstanding pledges to the amount of \$7,000. No attempt was made to collect the \$7,000 after it was decided to postpone the erection of the building until this fall.

The advisory board plan has proved a great success and a greater work has been rendered the public than ever before. Captain Nobbs, the local officer, has done a most creditable work. She has the confidence of leading citizens, and the members of the committee feel optimistic about the results of the drive.

The Rotary, Kiwanis and Lions clubs and others will co-operate with the county advisory board to make the effort the success the worthy cause merits.
