

## Country Clubbers Inspect New Site

Austin Country Clubbers received a brief "briefing" on their new properties—200 acres located south of the Colorado River and west of Montopolis Bridge—Thursday night when they were guests at a barbecue picnic staged by President F. L. Kuykendall and the Board of Directors to acquaint them with the new golf layout.

More than 400 members were present at the picnic grove several hundred yards from the site of the proposed new clubhouse. Early arrivals inspected parts of the course, now under construction under direction of Perry Maxwell of Oklahoma, one of the country's foremost designers of golf courses who also was present.

Although construction of the new clubhouse has not started, the course itself is expected to be in playing condition within 18 months—well within the time limit set for the City of Austin to take possession of the old Country Club properties in North Austin.
