

HICKORY HILLS GOLF COURSE OPENS SUNDAY

The Hickory Hills Golf course located four miles east of the city on the Cherry street road will be formally opened Sunday. It was announced this morning. It is expected that a large number of golfers will make the rounds of the course when it is thrown open to members tomorrow.

An exhibition match has been arranged for Saturday, June 6. The personnel of the exhibition hasn't been announced, but it will be a foursome between four well known players in this district.

Hickory Hills is in excellent condition for a new course and in a short time it is expected to be one of the greatest courses in this section of the country. Nine holes are ready for play and there isn't an artificial hazard on the entire course. There is to be an extra nine holes opened for play at a later date.

Many local golfers have become affiliated with the new club during the past few weeks and when the roster is completed there will be 300 members. The new course is to be operated in connection with the Kentwood hotel now under the course of construction on St. Louis near the Shrine Mosque by J. T. Woodruff. Hickory Hills is located on Mr. Woodruff's farm.
