## FINANCIAL PLAN OUTLINED

Standing Committee for Year Announced and Plans Are Discussed.

The bondholders, aggregating around 30 in number, are largely members of the club and interested in its affairs to the extent that they are expected to cooperate in the program.

The finance committee of the club will immediately begin plans to wage its drive for funds, it was stated.
