

Perry Golf Designer Leaves for Scotland

HENRYETTA, Sept. 8.—Perry Maxwell, constructing contractor of the Henryetta golf links, left for Edinburg, Scotland, where he will make a thorough study of the Scottish links and methods of the game as played in the country of its origin. In constructing the Henryetta links Mr. Maxwell was given a free hand to make the local links equal to any in the country, and it is with this intention that he goes to Scotland to study links and manners of the game as played by the originators of the sport. The Henryetta Country club, owners of the golf course, also have under construction a 20-acre artificial lake well under way, and expect to stock the waters with a large shipment of game fish when completed. Bathhouses will also be erected and pleasure boats installed for the use of the club members.
