

# MAXWELL BUYS COUNTY FARM

COUNTY PROPERTY SOLD BY THE  
COUNTY COMMISSIONERS THIS  
AFTERNOON.

The board of county commissioners sold the county farm that has been advertised for the past thirty days, to Perry Maxwell this afternoon for \$7,500, which is considered a bargain at that price.

There were only two bidders for the property, James Cruce and Perry Maxwell. Cruce's bid was \$575 less than

the farm adjoining the Country *Historical Society* be utilized as an addition to the *Society*. This land is rough and unfit for farming purposes. It is understood that Mr. Maxwell will offer the balance of the property for sale.

The county farm was purchased a few years ago by the commissioners for \$8,000, and since that time some extensive improvements have been made on the property. The farm is considered one of the best in this section of the county and its close proximity to the city limits makes it more valuable.
