

Notwithstanding the bitter fight made on Fross Maxwell he carried the 4th senatorial district by a largely increased vote. His majority in Webster is 682; in Caldwell, 34; and he lost Crittendon by only 185 votes—a republican loss of some 300 from last year's poll. This splendid result is peculiarly gratifying to the friends of senator-elect Maxwell, not only as evincing his great popularity but in that it secures to the district a man who will reflect distinguished honor upon its constituency.
