

# EDWARDS IS WINNER PRESIDENT CUP MATCH DORNICK HILLS CLUB

John Edwards has been announced as the winner of the President's Cup tournament, participated in during the past several weeks by the members of the Dornick Hills Country club, and which is regarded as the banner event of the year in local golf circles.
