

SEASIDE BENT DOES WELL HERE

New Type of Grass Introduced
on Dornick Hills by
Perry Maxwell.

Golfers are much pleased at the amazing development on six of the greens at Dornick Hills club achieved this fall and spring through the use of seaside bent, a new type of grass which Perry Maxwell, golf course designer, introduced here last October.

In 100 days the grass has gained remarkable growth and the greens are by far the best they have ever been at this season of the year, it is said.

Maxwell explained that this is the farthest south that seaside bent has been successfully grown. It is far superior to other types of grass for greens, being smoother, softer and much more resistant to cold weather and freezes.

Extension of the system to other of the greens at the club is planned.

Play over the course is picking up materially with the recent beautiful weather and interest in golfing generally is markedly on the increase, Maxwell said.
