

TWO GOLF COURSES READY WITHIN YEAR

Architect for Nichols Hills To Rush Completion:

Definite assurance that both the 18-hole and nine-hole golf course at Nichols Hills will be ready for play by late summer or early fall in 1929 was given Saturday by Perry D. Maxwell, golf architect under whose supervision the two courses are being constructed.

Maxwell also announced that Dr. A. Mackenzie of Leeds, England, who laid out the courses, is expected to reach Oklahoma City within a few weeks to assist in their completion. Dr. Mackenzie, Maxwell said, is considered the foremost golf architect of the world. Among his other honors is that of being the only golf architect ever elected adviser to the "Ancient and Royal club" of Scotland.

The first unit of Nichols Hills to be opened will be adjacent to the two courses, it was said at the Nichols offices.
