

STAR GOLF GIVES FRANCIS OUIMET AMERICAN TITLE

Defeats Travers by Wonderful
Playing for National
Championship.

WINNING MARGIN, 6 AND 5

Manchester, Vt., Sept. 5.—[Special.]—*Inspirational*—that is the adjective to be applied to the brand of golf which was shown and exhibited this afternoon on the links of the Ekwanok Country club here when Francis Ouimet of the Woodland Golf club, Massachusetts, defeated the four time champion, Jerome D. Travers for the title of amateur champion of the United States, 6 and 5.

The heavy defeat does not mean that Travers played badly; rather it means that the new champion played the most wonderful golf that has been witnessed in any amateur final. Ouimet was out in 34, a stroke under par, and if he had been forced to hole out on one or two of the greens where Travers conceded the hole he would have been a stroke, or possibly two strokes, less.
