Club members and visitors who are on hand for the opening will get a first-hand view of progress being made on the new \$48,000 club house which is now under construction. The sist has been leveled and forms placed for pouring foundation and concrete floor. A major portion of the initial plumbing work afready has been completed, too.

The single-story building will be located at the south side of the course, just off Gore, and is perched atop a hill overlooking the links to the north.

Although the big club house, with dance floor, lounge, locker and shower accomodations and other facilities, worth be completed until October, a temperary butment has been recented to care for the immediate needs of the membership.

Public Invited to View Work.


