

CLEAR GROUNDS AT HILLCREST

Architect Promises Club- house Plans Within Three Weeks

In three weeks plans will be completed for Hillcrest clubhouse and then, the building committee plans, every contractor will have an opportunity to figure on construction so the clubhouse will be ready for use this coming summer. The building committee and E. B. Delk, architect, have agreed on details of the house and Mr. Delk promises the plans in the time mentioned.

In the meantime there are twenty men uprooting trees and cutting through for the fairways on the new eighteen hole golf course that is to cost the local club between twenty and twenty-five thousand dollars. It isn't expected that the course will be ready for use this season, but a portion of it may be ready for play by fall, while all will be completed. Members will play at Oak Hills while the new course is getting set for the tramp of feet on the pleasure trail.

The club house is to be about \$60,000.

It will show to the Bartlesville-Tulsa highway as a building of light tan, or of pure white, and will be Spanish type, built of stucco and hollow tile, with varigated tile roof, two stories and basement.
