

Clubhouse Dream Of Twin Hills To Come True In Short While Contract For \$40,000 Modern Building Is Let By Carter; Club May Be Formed.

WORK on a \$40,000 two-story clubhouse at Twin Hills golf course will start within a month, Keefe Carter, owner of the club announced Friday. Dorset Carter, Keefe's father, let the contract after being in the city but a few days.

The building will be strictly modern throughout with locker room and showers, dining room, professionals' shop and all other conveniences that go with an up-to-date country club.

The new clubhouse will be located where the ninth green is located. The ninth green in turn, will be located about thirty feet west of the shack which now serves as professional's shop. This will lengthen the hole only a trifle, with the tee remaining where it is for a dog leg.

May Be Scene of Open

Clubhouse should be completed within two months and a half, Carter said. If the clubhouse is completed in this time and the course remains in as good a shape as it is now, the second annual Oklahoma City open golf tournament more than likely will be played over the Twin Hills course.

Carter said that he would be glad to donate the course for the open tournament. Last year the tournament would have been played over the course only for the fact that it did not have clubhouse accommodations.

Membership fee will not be raised and all golfers who have season tickets will have use of the clubhouse. Daily players will be charged with locker rent only, Carter said.

Club May Be Formed

When asked if he had plans for organization of a club, Carter replied that whatever golfers who have yearly tickets may do would be agreeable with him.

Keefe was presented with the Twin Hills course by his father after he had won the western amateur tournament in 1925. He has managed the club since, holding it open to all players with a greens fee of \$1 each day.

New clubhouse will be made of the native sandstone. Later, the club will build a practice fairway and an eighteen hole putting clock.
