

COUNTRY CLUB TO DOUBLE ITS COURSE

Will Accept 50 Additional Members

The Odessa Country Club will accept 50 additional memberships, it was announced today by club officials. This will give the club a total of 200 members.

It was also stated the course will be increased to 18 holes, doubling the present course size. The additional greens will be improved like the present course, giving them an 18-hole grass green layout.

The membership drive for the 50 started today and is expected to be completed within one week. Tom Pickering heads the committee, which includes R. T. Waddell, Luther A. Pickering has called a meeting of this committee Sunday morning at 10 o'clock at the Odessa Country Club.

The proposed new nine are scheduled to be built without any interference with the playing on the first nine holes. The new plans will also give the Odessa Country Club a 6,500 yard layout with a 37-34-71 par total that will have accommodations for 18 holes of championship calibre play for any and all golfers to shoot at.

It is said that the enlargement of the course has grown out of a very healthy need for more room for the local members and their Friends who play the green fee route, and also the looming accommodations for the golf players from the bombardier school which is located just five miles east of the Odessa club house on Highway 80.
