

BIG CROWD SEES 'GENE AND JOCK' AT DORNICK HILL

Gene Sarazen, the tawny Pittsburgh lad, who flashed last year across the golf world as its unheralded national open champion, and Jock Hutchinson, former national open champion, arrived in the city late last night as guests of the local Dornick Hills Country club and began an exhibition match at one o'clock this afternoon at the club links with Walter Critchlow and W.
