GOLF COURSE EXPERT DIES

Wendell P. Miller of Columbus, Ohio, Passes Away at Tulsa.

TULSA. Aug. 14.—(P)—Wendell P. Miller, Columbus, Ohio, widely known authority on golf course construction and irrigation, died in a hospital here today. Miller had been undergoing treatment following a heart attack several weeks ago. He was 39 years old.

Miller had been in Tulsa three months supervising the work on the new Southern Hills golf course. He had done similar work on some of the largest courses in the United States and also had supervised construction of courses in South America and Canada.

He is survived by his widow and a son, Wendell, who were with him here. Funeral services will be held at Columbus Friday.
