

# FOOTBALL FIELD BUILDING WORK STARTS AT ONCE

Approximately \$9000 Is Set  
Aside for Project, J. E.  
McCarty, County  
Director, Says.

## FIELD HAS BEEN CLEARED OFF

It Is Planned to Have Field  
Ready for Fall Football  
Season.

Official approval of the Walker athletic field as a CWA project was announced today by the state administrator and J. E. McCarty, county director, is authorized to proceed with the work of building the football field without delay. Approximately \$9000 was provided for labor on the project, a small portion of this sum to be used for material.

Promise was made that work on the field would be initiated without delay.

Transient workers have already cleared off the underbrush and timber and the way is clear for the excavation of the bowl to start. The plan is to push the operations to enable use of the field for the fall football season.

Perry Maxwell, veteran landscape engineer and golf-course designer, is to be in charge of the plans. He has already made a study of the project.

The tract of 10 acres was recently decided to the city as a park site by E. A. Walker of Oklahoma City.

### Field to Be Complete.

A complete athletic plant will be set up on the field. If plans carry through Ardmore will have one of the best football fields and athletic parks in the entire southwest. Natural lay of the land makes it ideal for the purpose.

Five or six other projects, including the graveling and repairing of several miles of road were also given official sanction in the message to McCarty.

It is believed that the CWA program is destined to move steadily ahead since the house yesterday endorsed the proposed \$950,000,000 appropriation for that work with only a few dissenting votes. The measure goes to the senate soon for its vote. Leaders believe it will be approved without opposition.
