

# Nichols Hills Golf Links Will Be Opened Labor Day

English Supervisor of Work  
To Return For  
Event.

Opening of golf courses at Nichols Hills was set definitely for Labor Day, Saturday, by John W. Coyle of G. A. Nichols, Inc.

Work on the two golf courses, one of 18 and one of nine holes, has been under way for more than a year, under the auspices of Perry D. Maxwell of Ardmore, and Dr. A. MacKenzie of Leeds, Eng. One of the final construction details, installation of water mains and a sprinkling system for the fairways, has been completed, and city water now is being used on the grass.

Doctor MacKenzie, who is in England, is expected to return late this summer and to be present at Nichols Hills when the courses are opened.

Final plans for the \$125,000 country clubhouse at Nichols Hills are expected to be announced within a few days, following the trip last week of Dr. G. A. Nichols to St. Louis,

where he was consulting with architects.

Preliminary sketches of the building have been completed, and floor plans are almost finished, it was said at the offices of G. A. Nichols, Inc.
