OCCC Panel Gives OK to Master Plan

Directors of the Oak Cliff Country Club Saturday stamped their approval upon a master plan for a \$550,000 golf course and club facilities building program.

Fred Maxwell, golf course designer, submitted a proposed layout for the links which will cover from 6,000 to 6,800 yards with a 35-35-71 par. All greens will be sodded with T-35 grass from the club's own nursery.

Four of the holes will involve water hazards from an artificial lake backed up by a 200-foot dirt dam. Three of the holes will cross the lake with the fourth to run parallel.

Included in the master plan are a swimming pool, deep well and pump, clubhouse and locker room, putting green and pitch-and-putt course and a lighted driving range.

A called membership meeting will be held during the week to approve the over-all plans.
