

WORK ON CLUBHOUSE TO PROCEED RAPIDLY

Fairways at Nichols Hills
Are Sodded.

With excavation for the \$125,000 country clubhouse at Nichols Hills well under way, members of the building department of G. A. Nichols, Inc., predicted Saturday that work on

Oklahoma City's newest "golf headquarters" will proceed rapidly.

Sprinkling of the fairways on the two Nichols Hills golf courses was carried on intensively all last week. Twenty-three large sprinklers, each capable of throwing a stream of water 100 feet, were kept at work.

The fairways have been sodded with bermuda grass, and are expected to be a carpet of solid green by the time the courses are opened for play on Labor day.
