

PERRY MAXWELL FOR CITY LINKS

Well Known Course Designer
and Builder Will Be Mem-
ber Municipal Golf Club.

Perry Maxwell, nationally known golf course designer and builder, has declared himself highly in favor of the establishment of a municipal links here and to show his interest has taken out a membership for a year and agreed to build the course without cost. This and the signing of several other new members has caused the special committee sponsoring the project to leave their charter membership list open for several more days.

Until the charter lists are closed the memberships paid in will be entitled to privileges for two players for one year's time. This is to encourage the members' wives to learn the game and to provide an added inducement to become a year member.

Twenty-five more members are needed approximately to insure sufficient funds to complete the work of laying out and building the course. If this number can be secured within the next few days the work will continue. Several enthusiasts have shown revived interest and this fact has led to the continuation of the opportunity to sign as charter members.

The fact that Mr. Maxwell, who designed the celebrated course at Dornick Hills country club, has agreed to build the municipal links makes the prospects for a sporty nine-hole course extremely luring. Mr. Maxwell is rated as one of the best informed experts in the southwest on golf and golf courses.
