

# Prairie Dunes Course Opens

## First Foursome Play By Owners Yesterday

One hundred members of the Prairie Dunes golf club will have an opportunity of playing their first rounds on the new course today. Opening with a nine hole layout, the Carey brothers, sponsors of the course, plan to increase the distance to 18 holes in the near future and later add 18 more holes.

The present nine holes offer Hutchinson golfers a 3,165-yard course. Men's par has been set at 35 with regulation women's figures 30 strokes per round.

Six of the holes are par 4, while two others are shortened to permit par 3s. Only the long 510-yard eighth hole is expected to require five strokes.

In the inaugural foursome yesterday, Ross Wilson, pro of the new course, and Dean Woods, construction engineer, of Ardmore, Okla., defeated Emerson June Carey and W. D. P. Bill Carey, 1 up. It was the first match played over the Prairie Dunes layout.

Wilson toured the first nine in an even par 35, but faltered on the back nine, taking a 41 for an 18-hole total of 76. Woods carded a 93, while June Carey came in with an 83 and Bill Carey with an 86.
